PART A

The IQAC met in the chamber of the Principal on 14-7-2010 to review the future plans set for the academic year 2009-10 and to chalk out the plan of action for the academic year 2010-11 for enhancement of quality of higher education in the college.

The plan of action :

1. To motivate the management for starting PG course in Political Science and History with fresh affiliation from newly started Parent University i.e. Rani Channamma University, Belagavi from the academic year 2011-12.
2. Decided to request the concerned to apply for financial assistance from external agencies like UGC for organizing national level seminar under the auspices of the college.
3. Decided to apply and request the authorities of Karnatak University for grant of permission to host Karnatak University Single Zone Competitions in at least two games/sports.
4. Decided to conduct coaching classes for entry in services for SC/ST, Minorities, Physically handicapped and other backward class students under the UGC assistance during XI plan period.
5. Steps to be initiated for purchase of books, equipments etc.
6. Teachers to be permitted to attend state, national level seminars, conferences and workshops to be held elsewhere.

7. Students should be encouraged and provided with full facilities for participation in sports meet, tournaments etc.
8. Students should be encouraged to take part in extra-curricular activities like NCC, NSS, debate, elocution, cultural activities etc.
9. Publication of college miscellany to be continued.
10. Classroom teaching should be given priority, so that, completion of syllabi, conducting of tests, tutorials, seminars etc. can go uninterrupted and prepare students for their examination.
11. Teachers and students should be encouraged to take part in all such activities, which help keep them updated.

Achievement :

A meeting of the members of IQAC was held in the chamber of the Principal on 11-7-2011 and discussed the achievement of the plan of action for the year 2010-11. The committee examined and verified documents pertaining to the achievements of the college and got confirmed the same. Committee resolved unanimously to thank staff for their pains taking efforts in achieving the chosen goals for the academic year 2010-11.

PART B

1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the college are as follows.
 - a. Efforts are on to improve the quality of higher education.
 - b. Infrastructures are augmented.
 - c. Performance indicators are designed and set.
 - d. Self evaluation is continued.
2. Motivated the management of the college to start PG courses in Political Science and History. Accordingly, the college did apply to Rani Channamma University, Belagavi for grant of affiliation for starting MA Political Science and MA History and got approval.
3. 2-day workshop on framing UG syllabi in 4 subjects viz. Botany, Zoology, Micro-Biology and Bio-Technology has been organized under the joint auspices of this college and Rani Channamma University, Belagavi during April 18-19, 2011.

5 teachers of this college namely Dr. S. S. Suvarnkhandi, Prof. A. S. Kandagal, Prof. H. S. Giddanavar, Mrs. J. P. Deshapande and Mrs. G. S. Vaidya have participated in the workshop and have contributed for training syllabi in the subjects mentioned above.

The vast experiences of the following teachers were used for revision of syllabi in the workshops which were held elsewhere. Prof. G. A. Anure (Marathi), Prof. B. I. Kaddi (Statistics), Prof. S. B. Pattadakall (Electronics), Prof. B. K. Galagali (Computer Science).

4. Continued the existing inter-disciplinary programmes for the year 2010-11.

5. As per the instructions received from the parent university appointed internal and external examiners for conduct of practical examination in all science subjects.
6. Teachers are encouraged to enroll for Ph.D. programme and 12 teachers have enrolled for Ph.D. degree of various universities.

Teachers are motivated to participate in national and state level seminars, conferences, workshops etc. 5 teachers have presented papers in national seminars which were held elsewhere. 4 teachers (Dr. B.M. Kalshetty, Dr. N.M. Rolli, Dr. S.S. Suvarnkhandi and Mr. B.I. Karalatti) have published 5 research papers in Journals of high repute.

7. 2-day state level seminar on 'Raobahadur' was organized on the occasion of birth centenary of litterateur Raobahadur under the joint auspices of Karnataka Sahitya Academy and college during October 11-12, 2010. Eminent critic Dr. Giraddi Govindaraj inaugurated the seminar.
8. UGC sponsored 4 MRPs (Dr. B.M. Kalshetty, Dr. N.M. Rolli, Prof. M.C. Sangannavar and Prof. R.C. Sheth) are completed and another 4 MRPs (Dr. P.D. Pol, Prof. H.S. Giddanavar, Prof. P.T. Rathod and Dr. S.G. Hiremath) are ongoing.
9. Research grants received from UGC during the year is Rs. 6,85,000/-.
10. Internal resources generated for the year Rs. 54,47,157/-
11. **Community service** : Blood donation camp was conducted on 29-10-2010 under the joint auspices of N.S.S. and N.C.C. units of the college in collaboration with Blood

bank of District Hospital, Bagalkot. Altogether 76 students have donated blood. Out of 76 students 71 men and 5 women students have donated.

The N.S.S. volunteers, N.C.C. cadets in particular and students of the college in general were actively involved in the community service like pulse polio, aids awareness campaign, anti-tobacco, anti-liquor campaigns etc. Adult education, sanitation, health awareness etc. are the activities carried out by the students towards community service.

A 7-day NSS camp was organized in the adopted village Madhurkhandi from 18-2-2011 to 24-2-2011.

12. One permanent teaching staff and 35 guest faculty were recruited during the academic year 2010-11.
13. Teaching-nonteaching ratio is 2:1.
14. New library building was constructed near the main lecture hall building at the approximate cost of Rs. 1.15 Crore. 773 books worth Rs. 1,10,103/- were purchased. 14 journals worth Rs. 11,860/- were subscribed. Inlibnet facility is continued. Additional books were issued to meritorious students who have scored above 65% in case of SC/ST students and 75% in case of GM students.
15. Feedback from students about teachers were taken improvements are suggested to teachers based on the feedback.
16. Unit cost of education Rs. 5,500/- (excluding salary component).

17. The college office is totally computerized. The admission process, issue of certificates, account keeping is computerized.
18. New library building is constructed and steps are initiated to build 4 classrooms on the first floor of existing building.

Common room and toilets for ladies are constructed under UGC assistance.

19. Broadband connection is upgraded by taking 10 N.M.E. terminals provided by BSNL.
20. Both teachers and students are provided with internet facility in the campus.
21. Students are given fee concessions, freeships , scholarships, cash prizes and poor aid fund. 57 students are given endowment cash prizes worth Rs. 25,650/-.

The college has helped the voluntary organizations like Vidya Poshak, Somaiyya Sugars Ltd., Sameerwadi etc. for identification of poor and needy students for extending financial help.

22. The past students association has felicitated Mr. K. S. Bilagi, Additional Registrar General of State High Court Circuit Bench, Gulbarga, who is alumnus of the college on 8-5-2010.

The past students association has organized a special lecture on 14-7-2010. Dr. Shivamoggi and Dr. Jayashree Kulkarni of Central Florida University, USA were the resource persons.

The alumnus and Assistant Director of Divisional Office of Employment Exchange, Belagavi Smt. Sadhana Pote addressed the students regarding how to prepare for competitive examinations and job opportunities on 20-10-2010.

Annual General Body meeting of the past students association was held on 6-11-2010 in the function hall of the college. Mr. G. S. Nyamagoud, M.L.C. and alumnus was the chief guest.

Past students association has extended financial assistance of Rs. 25,000/- to Miss. Shweta Kallur for doing first year of M.Sc. in Chemistry during 2010-11 and assured to extend financial assistance of Rs. 25,000/- for the year 2011-12 for completion of M.Sc.

Board of Directors of Alumni Association has met twice in a year.

23. Dr. H.G. Daddi and Dr. R.V. Metagudd are regularly checking the health of hostilities of women hostel. Health check up of all the students was taken up and valuable suggestions are given to the students. No student with life threat disease are found.

24. The following 5 students have been selected as Karnatak University Blues.

Mr. Tulajappa Bangi and Mr. Ramesh Bangi have participated in All India level Inter-University Swimming Championship which was held at Kolkata under the auspices of Kolkata University.

Mr. Shrishail Talawar represented Karnatak University in All India level Inter-University Gymnastic and MallKamb Championship (Men section) which was held

at Patiyala under the auspices of Punjabi University on 1-11-2010. He has secured 8th place in the championship.

Mr. Madappa Kurani played for Karnatak University in All India level Inter-University cycling championship (Men section) which was held at Amrutsar under the auspices of Gurunanak University. He has secured 4th place in the championship.

Mr. Appasaheb Kadapatti represented Karnatak University in All India level Inter-University cross-country championship for men which was held at Panthnagar organized by G.B.P. University of Agri-Tech. He has secured 10th place in the tournament.

The swimming team of the college emerged as overall champion in Inter-Collegiate Swimming Championship of Karnatak University.

The college has hosted Karnatak University Single Zone Inter-Collegiate Swimming Championship during July 28-29, 2010. The college has organized Karnatak University Single Zone Inter-Collegiate Weight Lifting and best physique competitions cum selection trials during August 27-28, 2010.

25. Outstanding sportspersons are given diet money, TA and DA for attending games, sports meets and tournaments organized elsewhere.

Gold medals : Miss. Sneha Sohani of B.A. secured the following two gold medals from Karnatak University, Dharwad for having secured highest marks in English (opt.) a) Rao Saheb Siddappa Manturshettar Gold medal b) Late Prin. B.S. Ganachari Memorial Gold medal.

NCC : CSUO Mujamil Moulvi and JUO Avinash Kale have attended three month TSC training. JUO Shrikant Shirol has attended one month mountaineering camp. Miss. Priyanka Dasaraddi participated in RD parade selection trials and dropped out in the last stage of selection process.

27. Guidance and Counseling cell is functioning effectively. The students are counseled for correction of their mistakes and improvement in their performance at different phases. Students are guided at every stage of routine activities apart from some special occasions.
28. Placement cell is active enough and has guided students for on and off campus interviews and 5 students are selected. (2 in Wipro's Wase on 4-2-2011, 2 in TCS on 2-1-2011 and 1 in Revenue department through call letter.)
29. The management of B.L.D.E. Association has given 45-day training to two non-teaching staff (Mr. G. M. Shashidhar and Mr. S. K. Badaradinni) in Spoken English and Communication Skill.
30. UGC Sponsored Add-on Courses in Tissue Culture, Sugar Science and Computer Technology were continued during the academic year 2010-11.
31. Teachers were permitted to attend seminars, conferences and workshops.

32. Brought out college miscellany 'Shataka Manthan'.
33. College has conducted 2-month Summer Vacation Swimming Camp for school children during April-May, 2010.
34. Library was kept open night upto 8 pm. during the examination days.
35. Remedial courses were conducted for the benefit of slow learners.
